Our Uniform Policy is based upon the following objectives:

It aims to be practical, comfortable and adaptable, and in line with our Equal Opportunities philosophy. It is applicable to all students from Nursery through to Y6.

SUITABLE CLOTHES FOR WINTER WEAR:

Boys

Dark grey trousers or dark grey knee length shorts (not chinos or jeans)
White polo shirt preferably with the school logo
Navy sweatshirt with school logo (compulsory)
Grey socks if shorts are worn
Black school shoes (no trainers)
Navy fleece with logo on
Mistral Jacket with logo or navy school coat

Nursery

Dark grey trousers, dark grey knee length shorts or navy joggers
White polo shirt preferably with the school logo
Navy sweatshirt with school logo (compulsory)
Navy fleece with logo on
Mistral Jacket with logo or navy school coat

Girls

Dark grey skirt or dark grey pinafore dress
Dark grey trousers (not chinos or jeans)
White polo shirt preferably with the school logo
Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo (compulsory)
Black tights or white socks
Black school shoes (not high heeled)
Navy fleece with logo on
Mistral Jacket with logo or navy school coat

Nursery

Dark grey skirt, dark grey pinafore dress, dark grey trousers or navy joggers
White polo shirt preferably with the school logo
Navy sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo (compulsory)
Black tights or white socks
Navy fleece with logo on
Mistral Jacket with logo or navy school coat

SUITABLE CLOTHES FOR SUMMER WEAR:

Boys

Dark grey shorts knee length
White polo shirt preferably with the school logo
Grey socks
Black shoes (no trainers)

Girls

Light blue/white gingham dress (not to include any other colour).
Dark grey skirt or grey knee length shorts
White polo shirt
Black shoes (no trainers or high heels)

PE KIT

The PE kit can be supplied in a bag by Just Schoolwear, our uniform suppliers. A change of clothes is necessary for personal hygiene and therefore PE bags must be kept in school at all times. **Please note no football shirts should be worn for PE.**

All items below should be in a PE bag with the child's name on it.

Plain white t-shirt
Navy shorts
Navy jogging bottoms and top
Socks
Trainers

OTHER ASPECTS OF OUR UNIFORM POLICY

Jewellery

Children may wear a watch (no smart watches permitted) and a plain pair of gold/silver stud earrings but **no other jewellery is permitted** due to health and safety issues and liability in case of loss.

If children wish to have their ears pierced this must be arranged at the beginning of the summer holidays so the ear has sufficient time to heal and the earrings can be removed so they can participate in PE sessions. Plasters may not be worn to cover earrings.

No other piercings are permitted.

Hairstyles

Hair must be of a natural colour; long hair must be tied back and items used to secure hair must be plain (for example, JoJo bows are not permitted to be worn in school).

Boys are not permitted to have lines in their hair.

Make up

For health and safety reasons make-up and nail polish are not permitted.

Bags

School bags (preferably purchased from Just Schoolwear) should only contain the pupils learning journal, reading book and homework. The content is restricted due to health and safety reasons as we don't want pupils carrying heavy bags.

Please note bags should be of a small size to enable them to be hung up on cloakroom pegs, rucksack are generally too big and cause trip hazards as there isn't room to hang them up.

PE bags should preferably be purchased from Just Schoolwear or must be a plain drawstring type bag with the pupil's name printed on.
